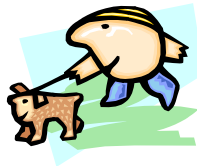

Delegate's Report

Delegate's Report
December 11, 2014
All Breed Committee
A survey was sent out on growing
and keeping members. We have
until Jan 15 to respond. They
want to know what worked for our
club.

Both the all breed and show
committee supported the Board's
decision on the territory issue.
It was suggested we follow up
with the hotels during the cluster.
If the hotels know the clubs will
take responsibility, hotels are
more likely to take dogs.
The point schedule for low entry
breeds was discussed. Some
were hoping to lower the amount
of dogs needed for a major to
increase entries. It was
suggested points be given for
group placement. Some felt it
was an area issue, not country
wide.

Reinstatement of disqualified
dogs was discussed. 19 applied
for reinstatement, only 7 dogs
were reinstated. They already
have to show liability insurance
and that the dog went thru CGG.
There is no history of disqualified
dogs being shown. Also, no judge
is required to do it. It was felt the
club where the reinstatement is to
take place should be named as
an additional insured.

On ramp judging: Board relies on
the Parent Clubs input. Once a
club asks for this change and it is
granted, they cannot change it
back for 5 years.

Judging approval: they got 750
responses. The basic framework
was approved and staff had
some recommendations for minor
changes. Roles will be different
that originally proposed. They are
hoping to make it a more
predictable outcome when judges
apply for more breeds. There are
presently 18 all rounders, some
no longer judging. 27% of the
judges are doing 80% of the
judging. Exhibitors are tired of

showing to the same judges.
There will be further discussion at
the February Board meeting.
Matches must have Breed
Standards on hand, either hard
copy or electronically.
Coordinating Committee
By Laws Committee: Reported
the delegates should
communicate to the clubs
regarding rules changes.
They are considering proposing
delegate judges being allowed to
charge \$150.00 fee.
General Meeting
December 12, 2014
Prospective Board members
gave speeches. The following are
running: Bob Amen, Carmen
Battaglia, Steve Gladstone, Tom
Davies, Greg Paveza.
We voted on the proposed
amendment to Chapter 14,
Section 11, regarding Field Trials.
It passed.
It was announced AKC has
sublet part of their space and
now has 75000 sq. ft. The
registration dept will start working
from home.
